

History

{ Home of Historic Firefighters Memorial Park }

For over 150 years this site has been an open public green space, originally set aside as a public square for residents of what was then known as the Village of Syracuse. As early as 1841, the area became known as Fayette Park.

The park's central focal point is the 19-foot tall Philip Eckel Monument, set within an oval-shaped pool with dual fountains on each side.

The Common Council officially changed the park's name to Fayette Firefighters Memorial Park on October 10, 1972, to honor and recognize those Syracuse firefighters killed in the line of duty, making the supreme sacrifice in service to the citizens of the City of Syracuse. In 1985, a fire bell dating from 1871 was added to the park and presently hangs from a 12-foot tall bell tower.
