Upon Acceptance, you will be required to submit by June 3, 2024:

- Copy of your propane permit if required from the Syracuse Fire Department
- Copy of your temporary food service permit if required from the onondaga County Health Department
- Certificate of Insurance
- Booth Fee
- Cleaning Deposit (For prepared food vendors only)



The Syracuse Arts & Crafts Festival is a nationally-ranked fine art and craft show and we will hold food vendors to the same high standards as the arts and crafts exhibitors.

Food Vendor Regulations

Temporary Food Service Permit – All vendors of prepared foods (see classifications above) are required to have a permit from the Onondaga County Health Department. Contact them at (315) 435-6607 or go to www.ongov.net/health/env/documents/MobileUnitPermit.pdf for an application. Vendors of pre-packaged food items do not require a permit.

Propane Permit - If propane is to be used in the preparation of food, contact the Syracuse Fire Department, Fire Prevention Bureau at (315) 448-4777, or go to https://app.oncamino.com/syracuseny/create-user for a permit application.

A UL listed, currently tagged and inspected, 2-1/2 lb. ABC fire extinguisher is also required.

Electrical Power - Please indicate on the application if you require electrical power. You must supply your own extension cords and power strips.

Water Access - No water connections are available, but an outdoor spigot may be used.

Insurance - Food Vendors must carry and provide proof of comprehensive general liability with coverage of not less than \$1,000,000 single limit, active during the term of the event. If accepted, you will need to submit a certificate of insurance indemnifying and holding harmless the Downtown Committee of Syracuse, the City of Syracuse, and their agents, officers, employees and volunteers from all claims from damage to property or bodily injury, including death, which may arise out of any permission issued herewith. The Downtown Committee (115 West Fayette Street, Syracuse, NY 13202) and the City of Syracuse (412 Spencer Street, Syracuse, NY 13204) must be named the insurance certificate holders, and listed as additional insured. This policy shall not be terminated or canceled prior to July 31, 2024.

Cancellation and Refund Policy - Food vendors canceling on or before July 1, 2024, will receive a refund of the booth fee and cleaning deposit. No refunds after this date.

Show Hours - 10 am to 6 pm on Friday and 10 am to 5 pm on Saturday & Sunday. Vendors must commit to operating during these hours. Vehicles must be removed from the Festival area during these times.

Tarps Required - Vendors of prepared foods, with the exception of those utilizing food trucks, must place tarps on the booth floor and sidewalk areas at all times to keep grease and food from the pavement. Failure to tarp your booth space will result in automatic forfeiture of your cleaning deposit.

Cardboard Boxes must be broken down and tied together at the end of each day.

Trash Receptacles - You must provide trash receptacles for your booth. Trash bins on the premises are not for vendors' use. You are responsible for keeping your area clean and sanitary at all times.

Vehicle ID - You will be supplied with a Vehicle Identification. This must be visible on the dash of your vehicle for the duration of the event.

Acceptance to participate this year does not guarantee acceptance in subsequent years.

Vendor Spaces cannot be reserved. Placement is not guaranteed from one year to the next and is subject to change.

Compliance - Vendors must comply with all Onondaga County Health Department and Syracuse Fire Department regulations. Failure to comply with these and the event regulations outlined above could result in the forfeiture of your cleaning deposit and/or the right to participate in future years.
